Every Monday night at IC beginning at 6:15 we gather to pray the Rosary.

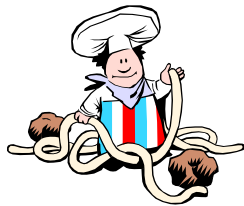
**CALLING ALL BAKERS AND BUYERS!**
