



A rock of faith

Of the two sisters of Bethany, Mary is usually considered the "spiritual" one, and Martha is relegated to the category of "hostess with the mostest." But after the death of their brother Lazarus, it is Martha who shows her spiritual mettle in her encounter with Jesus on the road. She gives her profession of faith with as much insight and certainty as does Peter when he was once asked by Jesus, "Who do you say I am?" 
