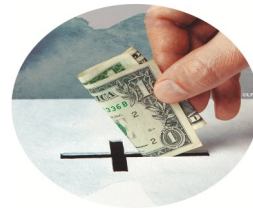

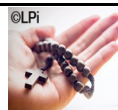

It's kind of like . . .

Jesus mentions the kingdom of heaven 38 times in Matthew's gospel. Clearly he wants us to understand exactly what it is. The kingdom is like a treasure buried in a field . . . it is like a merchant searching for valuable pearls. Crowther Memorial Chapel, located at **258 Stagecoach Rd in Sunapee, NH** (behind Dexter's Inn), is a tiny 10x12-foot stone chapel built in 1934 by the Crowther family. It serves as a memorial to their 15-year-old son, John, who died of leukemia .

Because of its hidden location, the chapel requires a short, gentle hike to reach:

- **Parking:** Park at the Dexter's Inn parking lot.
- **Trail:** Walk up the right side of the inn and follow the path leading into the woods.

Hours: The chapel is typically open to the public on the last Sunday of June, July, August, and September from 11:30 am to 1:30 pm.

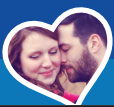
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
