Two important stories in scripture—God's coming to Elijah in a "tiny whispering sound" and Jesus' walk on the water—say a lot about our spiritual journey. Elijah was not in a good way. He lived in a bad place with a bad king, the other prophets were dead, and Queen Jezebel had a contract out on his life. Saint Peter also had a problem: Boldly stepping out on the water to walk to his Lord, he got scared and started to go under. For both these holy people in distress, God came to the rescue. When things get tough, we can, like them, lose our nerve. But we know God will answer. The trick may be to have that confidence before we get into trouble.

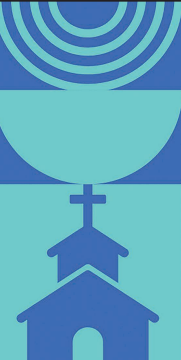
