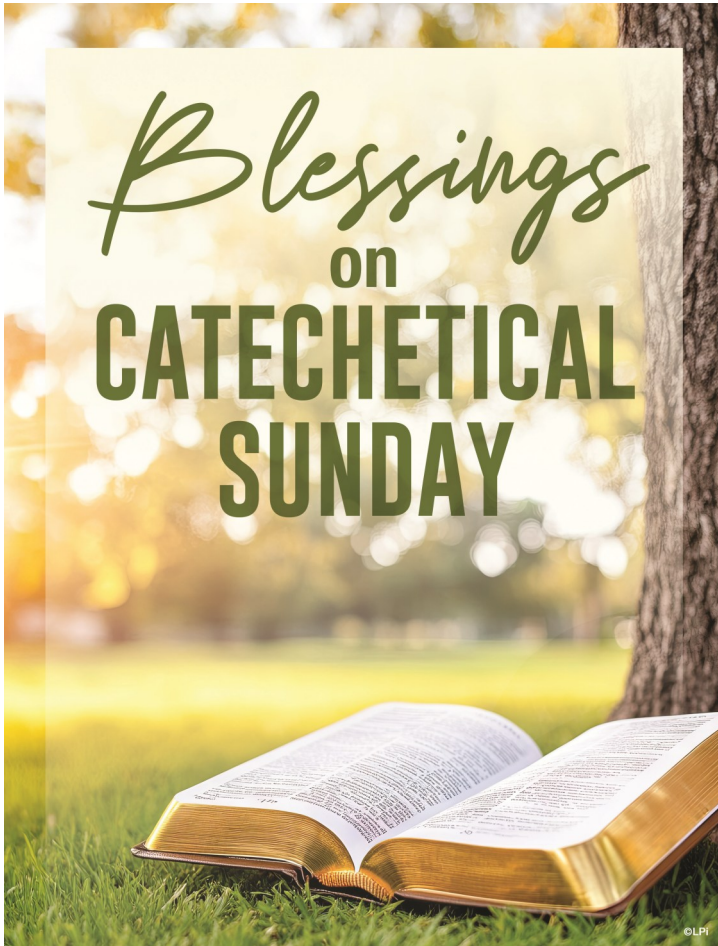

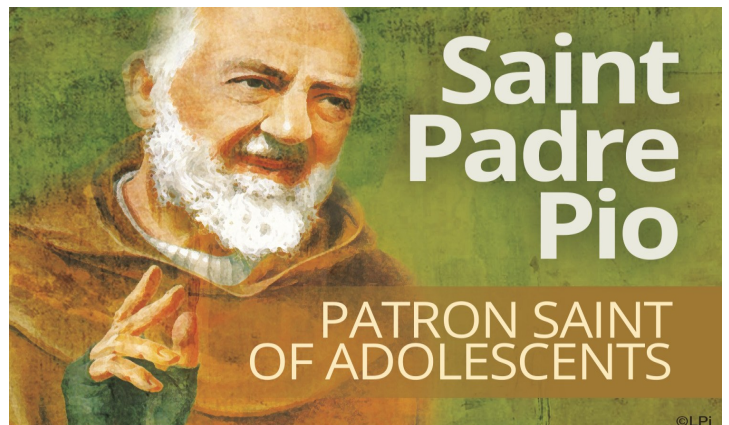

St. Pius of Pietrelcina, known as Padre Pio, was born Francesco Forgione in Italy in 1887. A Capuchin Franciscan priest, he was marked by illness, deep prayer, and the stigmata. Serving in San Giovanni Rotondo, he devoted long days to Mass, confession, and blessing the sick. He inspired the Casa Sollievo della Sofferenza hospital and was canonized in 2002.
